

OPTIMAL COMPUTING PRIVACY POLICY

This Statement is effective as of October 2013.

Your privacy is important to OPTIMAL COMPUTING. So we have developed a Privacy Policy that covers how we collect, use, disclose, transfer, and store your information.

Please take a moment to familiarize yourself with our privacy practices and feel free to contact us if you have questions.

1. SCOPE

This Privacy Statement applies only to www.optimalcomputing.be. It does not apply to other Web sites that have their own Privacy Statement.

2. COLLECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

OPTIMAL COMPUTING collects many kinds of information in order to operate effectively and provide you the best products and services.

How we collect

Personal information is collected when you register, sign in and use our Web site and Software.

What we collect:

- Information about yourself, such as your name, the name, the structure, VAT number, the address, bank datas, email address, domain of activities of your company that will be collected when you sign up to use our Web site.
- Information that tells us how you interact with our Web site, including the browser you're using, your IP address, location, cookies or other unique IDs, the pages you visit and features you use.

3. USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

OPTIMAL COMPUTING uses the information we collect about you in order to:

- Allow you to use the Software and to enforce the Software License Agreement.
- Send you business and support messages such as those related to payments, expiration of your subscription or enquiry about the use of our software.
- Send you information about OPTIMAL COMPUTING, new application releases, special offers, and similar information.

Before we do so, we will offer you the opportunity to choose whether or not to have your information used in this way. You may at any time choose not to receive marketing materials from us by following the unsubscribe instructions included in each e-mail you may receive or by contacting us directly (please refer to "Privacy Questions and Access" below).

- Conduct market research about our customers, their interests, and the effectiveness of our marketing campaigns.
- Reduce fraud, software piracy, and protecting our customers as well as OPTIMAL COMPUTING.
- Keep a record of your communication to help solve any issues you might be facing.

4. SHARING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

Except as described in this Privacy Policy, we will not disclose your Personal Information to a third party without your consent.

OPTIMAL COMPUTING may share your Personal Information:

- With its future resellers and other sales partners.
- When we are required to provide information in response to a court order, or other applicable law or legal process.
- When we have a good faith belief that the disclosure is necessary to prevent or respond to fraud, defend our websites or applications against attacks, or protect the property and safety of OPTIMAL COMPUTING, our customers and users, or the public.
- If we merge with or are acquired by another company or if we sell an OPTIMAL COMPUTING website, application, or business unit or all or a substantial portion of our assets are acquired by another company. In those cases your information will likely be one of the assets that are transferred.
- We may share or publish aggregate information that doesn't specifically identify you, such as statistical information about visitors to our Web site or statistical information about how customers use our applications.

5. STORAGE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

All your Personal Information is stored in a secure server hosted in the Cloud Amazon called "Amazon Web Services Infrastructure".

6. SECURITY

We understand that the security of your Personal Information is important.

We use a variety of security technologies and procedures to help protect your Personal Information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure.

That is why we store the Personal Information you provide on servers secured by a password and by encryption.

7. NOTIFICATION OF CHANGES

OPTIMAL COMPUTING will from time to time update its privacy statements to reflect customer feedback and changes in our services.

When we post changes to a statement, we will revise the "last updated" date at the top of the statement. If there are material changes to the statement or in how OPTIMAL COMPUTING will use your Personal Information, we will notify you either by prominently posting a notice of such changes before they take effect or by directly sending you a notification.

We encourage you to periodically review the privacy statements for the products you use to learn how OPTIMAL COMPUTING is protecting your information.
